


OUR NEW LOGO

TESTING A SHUTTLE FOR SPEED

- 1. To test a shuttle, a player shall use a full underhand stroke which contacts the shuttle over the back-boundary line. The shuttle shall be hit at an upward angle and in a direction parallel to the side lines.
- 2. A shuttle of correct speed will land not less than 530 mm and not more than 990 mm short of the other back boundary line as in Diagram.
