Head Coach

GBDBA is seeking a head coach for the GBDBA 2020 team that will participate in the Ontario Winter Games in Orillia, Ontario from February 27 to March 1, 2020.

Criteria for HEAD COACH

- Must have a minimum NCCP Level II certification as a badminton coach
- Should have experience with team events and with selection processes
- Must be an active supporter of the GBDBA, it's players and clubs
- Youth coaching experience required, preferably at a GBDBA club
- Must demonstrate proof of police check

Responsibilities of HEAD COACH

- Contact all athletes after selection process to confirm the final selection
- Arrange team practice and practice matches
- Select playing combinations for all competitive events for which GBDBA is funding the team
- Oversee all aspects of the coaching portion of the OWG team programme
- Act as head coach at the Ontario Winter Games and any other such team events entered
- Communicate with parents of Team Members as needed
- Provide a report to GBDBA Board of Directors on the Team's performance with suggestions for future games

Honorarium for HEAD COACH

- A suitable honorarium shall be paid for fulfillment of duties at the end of the Ontario Winter Games 2020.

Application Deadline for HEAD COACH

- Qualified coaches who are interested in this position shall provide a letter of intent outlining qualifications and suitability for the position to GBDBA President at president@GBDBA.ca by July 12th, 2019. The successful candidate will be notified by July 31, 2019.
